(45% alpaca, 25% wool, 30% polyamide)
50 gr/170 m

Drops Nord Mix – 03 pearl grey
(45% alpaca, 25% wool, 30% polyamide)
50 gr/170 m

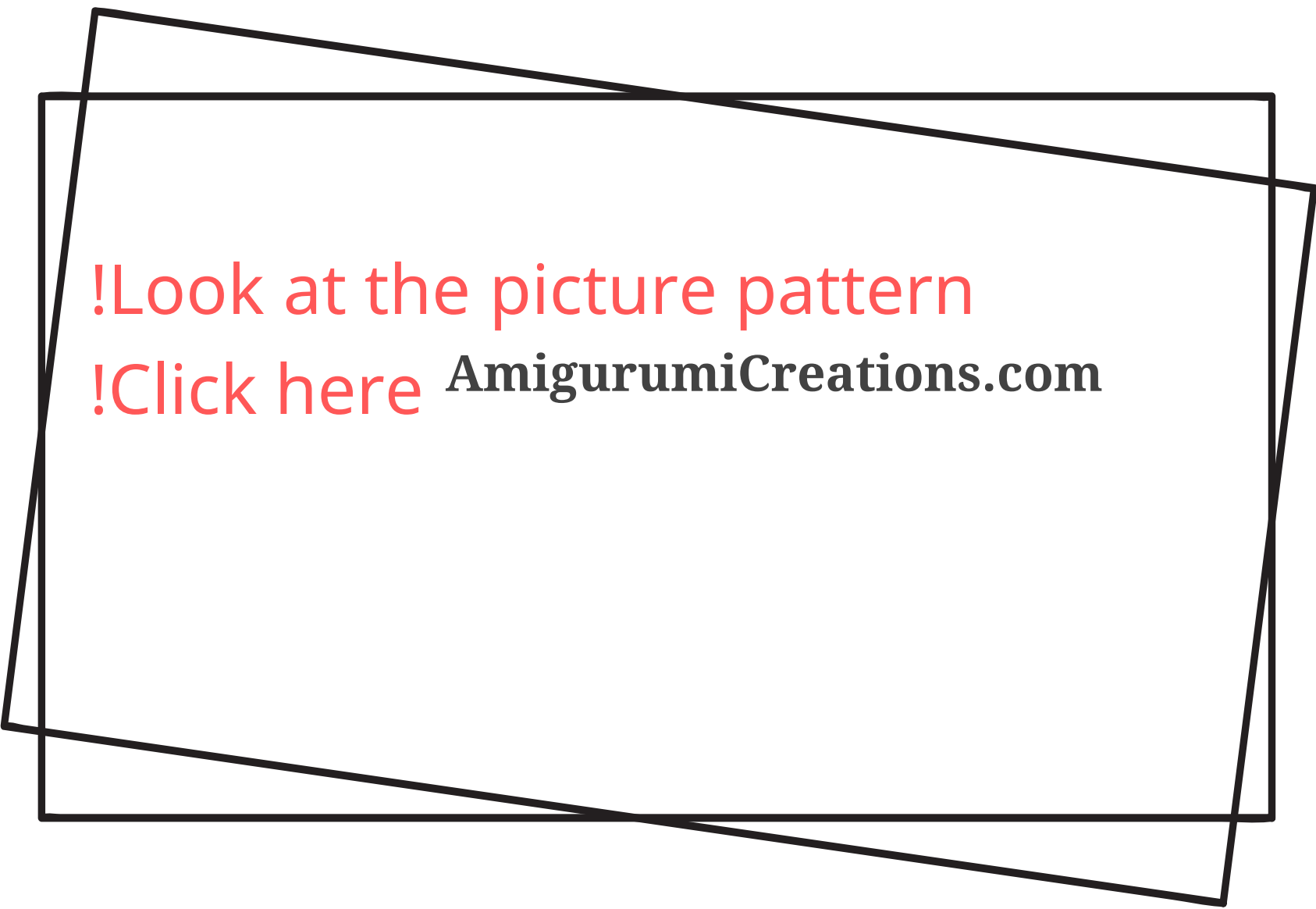
Drops Nord Uni Colour – 18 goldenrod
(45% alpaca, 25% wool, 30% polyamide)
50 gr/170 m

Alize Cotton Gold – 55 white
(55% cotton, 45% acrylic)
100 gr/330 m

Drops Love You 9 – 117 ice blue
(100 % cotton)
50 gr/125 m



- 2. Fiber filling
- 3. Hook size 2 mm
- 4. Tapestry needle for sewing
- 5. Scissors
- 6. Plastic eyes 6 mm in diameter

Start working with grey color:

1. 6 sc in mr
2. 6 inc (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)
6. (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)
7. (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)
8. (13 sc, inc) x 3 (45)
9. 45 sc
10. (14 sc, inc) x 3 (48)
11. 48 sc
12. (15 sc, inc) x 3 (51)
13. (16 sc, inc) x 3 (54)
- 14.-16. 54 sc (3 rnds)
17. **Change yarn color to the pale-grey color:** (8 sc, inc) x 6 (60)
18. (9 sc, inc) x 6 (66)

Start working with pink color

Work in turning rows:

1. 2 ch
2. inc, 1 ch (2)
3. 2 inc, 1 ch (4)
4. **Change yarn color to the grey color:** 4 inc, 1 ch (8)
5. 8 sc, 1 ch (8)

Leave a long tail for sewing

Crochet round detail in a circle

Cheeks (x2)

Start working with beige color:

1. 6 sc in mr
2. 6 inc (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
5. 24 sc
6. 9 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc, 3 inc (30)

Leave a long tail for sewing

Muzzle

Start working with white color:

1. 6 sc in mr
2. 2 inc, 1 sc, 2 inc, 1 sc (10)
3. 1 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, 3 inc, 1 sc (16)
4. 16 sc

Sew the muzzle on to the head. Stuff.

Sew the cheeks on to the head. Stuff.





Ears (x2)

Start working with grey color:

1. 6 sc in mr

Leave a long tail for sewing

Mouth

Start working with pink color

Work in turning rows:

1. 6 sc in mr
2. **Change yarn color to the white color:** 1 ch, 6 sc (6)

Start forming the muzzle:

1. Sew the nose on to the head. Sew the mouth on to the head.
2. Insert the plastic eyes, 6 mm in diameter. The gap between the eyes should be muzzle and cheeks.
3. Embroider eyes: insert the white threaded needle on top of the eye and thread it to the bottom as shown in the picture. Bring the thread out near the second eye and repeat the same steps.
4. Sew the ears on to the head.





Legs (x2) Look at the picture

Start working with grey color:

1. 6 sc in mr
2. 6 inc (12)
3. 12 sc
4. 6 sc, 3 dec (9)
5. 9 inc (18)
6. (1 sc, inc) x 9 (27)
- 7.-8. 27 sc
9. **Change yarn color to the blue color:** 27 sc

10. **Blo** 27 sc

Do not cut off the thread on the second leg; if necessary, move the safety pin so that when joining the legs both of them look in the same direction.

Continue crocheting the body

Ch 3, join first leg, place a marker, this will be first st of the row now, and crochet:

1. 27 sc on the first leg, 3 sc on the chain, 27 sc on the second leg, 3 sc on the chain (60)

- 3.-5. 66 sc (3 rnds)
6. (9 sc, dec) x 6 (60)
7. 60 sc
8. (8 sc, dec) x 6 (54)
9. 54 sc
10. (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)
11. 48 sc
12. **Change yarn color to the grey color: Blo** 48 sc
13. (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)
- 14.-16. 42 sc (3 rnds)
17. (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)
18. 36 sc

Hands (x2) look at the pictures

Start working with grey color:

1. 6 sc in mr
- 2.-3. 6 sc
4. (1 sc, inc) x 3 (9)
5. (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12)
6. (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)
- 7.-12. 15 sc (6 rnds)

- Sew the head on to the body
- Sew the hands on to the body

The strap for pants

Start working with yellow color

Work in turning rows:

1. 31 ch
2. 30 sc

Sew the strap on to the pants

Cup

1. 6 sc in mr
2. 6 inc (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4. (5 sc, inc) x 3 (21)
5. (6 sc, inc) x 3 (24)
6. 24 sc

Leave a long tail for sewing

Visor

Work in turning rows:

1. 6 sc in mr, 1 ch
2. 6 inc, 1 ch (12)
- 3.-4. 12 sc, 1 ch (12)

Sew the visor on to the cup





Scarf Look at the picture

Work in turning rows:

1. 120 ch
2. 118 sc, 4 sc in last stitch, 118 sc
